Registration, Withdrawals and League Structure

If you wish to withdraw a team from the above league structure or request an exceptional relegation, despite the previously announced deadline (1 June) having passed, please send an email to svbk@svbk.dk as soon as possible.

If you wish to register a new team in the lowest division, this must be done no later than Sunday, 9 August. New teams can be registered here:

The following divisions are open for new registrations: Women's Series 3, Men's Series 3 and Mix Division 2.

Please note that the invitation and related information have not yet been updated for the new season.

Hall Availability, Fixture-Free Requests and Competition Regulations

Hall availability and fixture-free requests must be submitted no later than Sunday, 21 June.

For any new teams registered in the lowest division, the forms should be completed as soon as possible and no later than 9 August. If this is not possible, please notify SVBK.

Hall availability should be submitted here:

Availability can be entered in multiple submissions if necessary. If any previously submitted times need to be removed, please email svbk@svbk.dk as soon as possible.

The submitted hall availability must include all allocated hall time, including setup and warm-up time before the first match of the day (typically one hour), time allocated for divisional matches, and any Kids, Teen or Youth tournaments hosted by the club.

The senior season will run from Saturday, 19 September until Sunday, 18 April. A limited number of Kids and Youth tournaments, as well as seeding matches, will also take place after 18 April, so please try to reserve hall time for these activities as well (up to and including 2 May).

If you have any requests regarding match order or preferred match times for specific teams, these can be entered in the comments field of the form.

Hall availability within the municipalities of Copenhagen and Frederiksberg has already been reported directly to SVBK, except for school sports halls.

It is also important that you submit your fixture-free requests (this applies to the senior regional league competition only) so that we can take them into consideration where possible.

Please remember to request fixture-free weekends for school holidays, Christmas parties, the opening rounds of the season (some clubs and teams are surprised every year that the season begins on the penultimate weekend of September), youth tournaments, and similar activities.

However, I would like to emphasise—particularly for teams with youth players—that there are limits to how many scheduling considerations can be accommodated across all divisions. Please ensure that only your most important and highest-priority requests are submitted.

As the Youth Committee will not meet until 9 June, the full youth calendar is not yet available; only the fixed weekend tournament dates have been confirmed. As soon as the Youth Committee has met and the calendar has been finalised, I will send the information to all clubs.

Requests must be submitted one team at a time, so clubs with multiple teams may wish to distribute the responsibility among their respective team managers or representatives.

The competition regulations (Propositions) for the 2026/27 season have not yet been updated, as they must be approved by the Board later in June. Once the regulations are finalised, we will distribute the information to all clubs.

Please note that SVBK reserves the right to amend the regulations subsequently if changes are made to the national federation's regulations and/or if new playing rules, which are tested in this period, will affect the competition regulations.

We strongly recommend reading the regulations carefully once they have been published. In previous seasons, several clubs have encountered difficulties or misunderstood certain rules simply because they had not read the regulations thoroughly. It is unfortunate to lose matches by default or receive fines for issues that could have been avoided through familiarity with the rules.

And please remember: if you are unsure about anything, it is always better to ask one question too many than one too few. However, we also encourage clubs to be as specific as possible when contacting us.

Youth Competitions

Clubs expecting to enter Kids, Teen and/or Youth teams next season must complete the following form: <https://svbk.dk/vaerktoejskassen/info-blanketter/ungdomsskema>

The form should include both the teams you expect to enter and the tournaments you would like to host. Clubs that only have Kids and Youth teams must also remember to submit hall availability by 21 June.

Within the “Klubportalen”, however, you can update your coaches and players if any individuals have left the club since the last update.
